The City has received an enquiry from a resident that the Bus Stop located on the southern side of Queen Street, Rosebery opposite Princes Avenue is redundant and no longer used by buses.

Comments

The kerb space on the southern side of Queen Street, Rosebery, east of Botany Road, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as "Bus Zone".

The City considers it is appropriate to remove the Bus Zone and reallocate the kerb space as "1P 8.30am-6pm Mon-Fri, 8.30am-12.30pm Sat" to match with the adjacent parking restrictions.
