Background

A resident of Belmont Street has requested consideration to remove the existing Mobility Parking which he no longer needs.

Comments

The kerb space on the western side of Belmont Street, Alexandria north of Huntley Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as "Disability Parking Only".

On-site inspection shows there is a need to provide unrestricted parking to improve resident access to on-street parking.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 377 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
