Recommendations

- (A) On the southern side of Bijou Lane, Haymarket between the points 0 metres to 99 metres west of Quay Street as "No Stopping"; and
- (B) On the western side of Quay Street, Haymarket between the points 20 metres and 36 metres north of Bijou Lane as "Loading Zone Ticket 6am-6pm Mon-Fri 6-10am Sat and 4P Ticket 6-10pm Mon-Fri 10am-10pm Sat 8am-10pm Sun & Public Holidays".

Background

A resident of Bijou Lane has requested consideration for "No Stopping" restrictions in Bijou Lane to improve access and safety in the laneway.

Comments

Parking in Bijou Lane and Quay Street, Haymarket, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as "No Parking" and Ticket Parking.

Bijou Lane is a two way "No Through Road" that provides access to residential and commercial unit car parks. The laneway is approximately 5.2 metres wide. When a vehicle stops in the "No Parking" zone to complete deliveries, it restricts vehicle access and impacts on road safety for all road users in the laneway.

On-site inspection shows there is a need to provide a "No Stopping" restriction to improve traffic safety in the laneway.

In a "No Stopping" Zone vehicles must not stop at any point on the road or kerb in the direction of the arrow, unless in an emergency.

On-site inspection shows there is a need to provide a "Loading Zone" in Quay Street to assist businesses with their deliveries.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 220 letters sent out with no responses supporting the proposal or responses opposing the proposal.

Financial

Funds are available in the current budget.
