Background

NSW Health has a Child and Family Health Centre in Power Avenue, Alexandria and has requested consideration of an authorised vehicle parking zone in the street, to allow for access to vehicles conducting community visits to and from the centre.

Comments

The kerb space on the northern side of Power Avenue, Alexandria between Park Road and Loveridge Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently unrestricted for parking.

To allow NSW Health staff to park near their centre, it is proposed to allocate “No Parking 8am-5pm Mon-Fri Authorised NSW Health Service Vehicles Excepted”.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 143 letters sent out with nil responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
