Background

A member of the community has requested consideration of a wheelchair-friendly taxi pickup and drop-off in Elizabeth Street, Sydney outside their workplace.

Comments

The kerb space on the western side of Elizabeth Street, Sydney between Goulburn and Liverpool Streets, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as "No Stopping" between the hours of 6am to 10am and 3pm to 8pm.

On-site inspection shows there is a need to provide pick-up and drop-off location for taxis that is mobility vehicle friendly. The proposed location is situated just after a driveway which can be used for access from the roadway and onto the footpath.

The parking change will allow taxis up to one (1) minute to pick-up and drop-off passengers during the hours of 6am-10am and 3pm to 8pm. Parking restrictions outside of these hours will remain as is.

Transport for New South Wales has been consulted and raised no objections.

Consultation

The City notified local residents and businesses in the area. There were 215 letters sent out with no responses supporting or objecting to the proposal.
