**Advice**

**Background**

Residents of Macleay Street have requested consideration of "No Stopping" in their street to improve driveway safety and sight lines when entering and exiting their driveway.

**Comments**

The kerb space on the eastern side of Macleay Street, Potts Point north of Crick Avenue, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as "1/4P Free, 1P Ticket 8am-6pm Mon-Fri and 1/4P Free, 4P Ticket 6-10pm, Mon-Fri, 8am-10pm Sat-Sun".

On-site inspection shows there is a need to provide a "No Stopping" restriction to improve sight distance as well as overall driveway safety for vehicles entering and exiting the driveway.

### **Consultation**

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 666 letters sent out with three responses supporting the proposal and four responses opposing the proposal.

The opposing submissions were due to loss of on-street parking. One submission indicated that visibility issues were due to lack of parking and therefore resulting in illegally parked vehicles across driveways to make deliveries.
