Background

Due to a recently approved development application at 495 Crown Street, Surry Hills, a new driveway will be constructed. As such, the kerb space is no longer suitable for parking in the rear laneway.

Comments

The kerb space on the eastern side of Jesson Lane, Surry Hills south of Jesson Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as "2P 8am-10pm Permit Holders Excepted Area 18".

Currently there is approximately one car space near the proposed new driveway. The construction of the new approved driveway would result in approximately 3 metres of kerb space remaining. To maintain accessibility of the proposed new driveway, it is proposed to signpost the remaining kerb space as "No Parking".

Consultation

The City notified local residents and businesses in the area. There were 60 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
