Background

Residents of Little Young Street, Redfern has requested consideration of "No Parking" on a waste collection day to improve access and safety for cleansing vehicles in the laneway. It is also proposed to install permit parking on other days to encourage vehicle turnover and freeing up spaces for residents in the area.

Comments

The kerb space on the western side of Little Young Street, Redfern just north of Cooper Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently unrestricted for parking.

The road width in Little Young Street is approximately 4 metres. When cars are parked in the unrestricted kerbside parking spaces, it leaves only 1.9 metres for waste vehicles to access through the laneway. Therefore, it is proposed to provide "No Parking 6am-6pm Wed Only" restrictions in those unrestricted spaces on Little Young Street during waste collection periods. There is a further need to provide timed permit parking to increase parking turnover and improve resident access to on-street parking in this kerb space.

The proposed changes would limit any vehicle which does not have a permit to two (2) hours of parking from 8am to 10pm, Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday to Saturday where the signs are installed.

Residents with an Area 41 parking permit will be exempt from the two-hour time limit.

A two-hour parking limit is preferred for streets in the inner residential areas as it better balances the long-stay parking needs of permit holders with the needs of all households to use parking for visitors, family, carers and tradespeople.

The City's Waste Management Team has been consulted with the change and supports the need for "No Parking 6am-6pm Wed Only" to assist with waste collection vehicle access.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 286 letters sent out with two responses supporting the proposal and no responses opposing the proposal.

Financial

Funds are available in the current budget.
