Background

The City's Waste Management Team has requested consideration of "No Parking" to improve access for waste vehicles in Salisbury Lane, Rosebery.

Comments

This kerb space on the western side of Salisbury Lane, Rosebery, south of Cressy Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently unrestricted for parking.

The road width in Salisbury Lane is approximately 4 metres. When cars are parked in the kerbside space, it leaves only 1.9 metres for waste vehicles to access through the laneway. Therefore, it is proposed to provide "No Parking 5am-6pm Monday and Thursday Only" restrictions in those spaces on Salisbury Lane during waste collection periods. This will ensure that waste vehicles can operate in a safe and efficient manner on collection days. The kerb space can remain unrestricted on non-garbage collection time/days.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 103 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
