Background

A resident of Toogood Lane, Erskineville has requested consideration of "No Stopping" in Union and Newman Streets, Newtown to improve access and traffic flow of vehicles.

Comments

On-site inspection shows there is a need to provide "No Stopping" signage to clarify NSW Statutory Road Rules.

Signs are not required to enforce this rule and it is the responsibility of drivers to be aware of all current traffic and parking laws. However, due to consistent illegal parking close to the corners at this intersection, the City will install signage to clarify the "No Stopping" restriction to resolve safety concerns received about this location.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 124 letters sent out with three responses supporting the proposal and one response opposing the proposal.
