**Background**

The City's waste and cleansing services has requested consideration of "No Stopping Council Vehicles Excepted" in Sussex Street to improve on-street parking access for waste collection during both the day and night times.

### **Comments**

The kerb space on the eastern side of Sussex Street, Haymarket between Hay Street and Little Hay Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as "No Stopping".

To improve on-street parking access for waste and cleansing services, it is proposed to reallocate "No Stopping" to "No Stopping Council Vehicles Excepted".

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 184 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
