Background

A resident of Dwyer Street, Chippendale has requested consideration of No Parking in the street to improve pedestrian access to their building.

Comments

The kerb space on the southern side of Dwyer Street, Chippendale east of Kensington Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently "2P Ticket 8am-10pm Permit Holders Excepted Area 32".

Previously, raised planters were placed on the road reserve to stop vehicles parking across the entrance of the building and this occurred for many years. However, the planters have recently been removed and cars are now parking across the entrance of the building, causing obstruction.

Therefore, it is proposed to install a "No Parking" restriction in this location to ensure cars are not blocking access to the building.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 217 letters sent out with one response supporting the proposal and one response opposing the proposal due to loss of parking.
