Background

Parking ticket data indicate that the loading zone spaces in Phillip Street is currently underutilised on Saturdays.

The Premier's Department has requested consideration to update the parking signage to reflect the department's name change.

Comments

The kerb space on the western side of Phillip Street, Sydney between Martin Place and Hunter Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as "No Parking 6am-Midnight Mon-Fri Authorised NSW Government Vehicles Excepted", "Loading Zone 6am-10am Saturday" and "4P Ticket 10am-10pm Saturday, Sunday & Public Holidays".

Parking ticket data demonstrates that the utilisation of the existing loading zone along Phillip Street is very low, therefore it is proposed to reallocate the loading zone as ticket parking spaces to improve kerbside use.

The Premier's Department has requested the parking signage to be updated as "Authorised PD Vehicles Excepted" to reflect the department's name change.

Consultation

The City consulted with local residents and businesses in the area. There were 27 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
