Advice

Background

A restaurant on Bijou Lane, Sydney has requested consideration of reinstating "No Parking" outside their frontage to support pick up and drop off deliveries to their own and adjacent businesses.

The laneway was previously signposted as "No Parking" full time and "No Stopping" restrictions on Bijou Lane were installed in March 2023 to improve vehicle access through

the laneway. The parking changes were endorsed by the Committee at its March 2023 meeting.

Comments

The kerb space on the northern side of Bijou lane, Haymarket west of Quay Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as "No Stopping".

On-site inspection shows there is limited parking availability at Quay Street and a single "No Parking" space would improve access to Bijou Lane for deliveries.

The laneway is a 5.7m wide cul-de-sac and a single stopped vehicle is unlikely to cause any access issues to properties on Bijou Lane. Traffic volumes on the laneway are also low.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 210 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.

Financial

Funds are available in the current budget.
