Comments

The kerb space on the western side of William Street, Redfern between Short and Wells Streets, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as "2P 8am-8pm Mon-Fri Permit Holders Excepted Area 41".

On-site inspection shows there is a need to introduce section of "No Stopping" restriction to allow access to the property.
