Background

Surrounding local businesses of Thurlow and Bourke Streets, Redfern have requested consideration of a “Loading Zone 8am-6pm Mon-Fri” in Thurlow Street to improve on-street parking availabilities for deliveries.

Comments

The kerb space on the northern side of Thurlow Street, Redfern between Bourke and Stanley Streets, where the changes are proposed, is currently unrestricted for parking.

On-site inspection shows there is a need to provide a "Loading Zone 8am-6pm Mon-Fri" during business hours to cater for local businesses as there are no other Loading Zones nearby.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 99 letters sent out with two responses supporting the proposal and two responses opposing the proposal.

The submission opposing the proposal has concerns with loss of parking for residents. However residents will still be able to park in this location at nights and on weekends.
