# Background

A resident has requested consideration of "No Stopping" in Derwent Lane to improve laneway access.

# Comments

Both sides of Derwent Lane, between Parramatta Road and Derby Place, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as "No Parking".

Derwent Lane is a one-way road and 4 metres wide. In narrow streets like Derwent Lane, cars parking in the laneway obstructs or prevent vehicles from passing through. To improve access to the laneway, it is proposed to introduce "No Stopping" restrictions in Derwent Lane.

The City will install "No Stopping" signage and yellow line markings in Derwent Lane to improve driver awareness of the laneway restrictions.

#### Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 26 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
