Background

The City is considering installing "No Stopping" in Murray Street, Waterloo to improve traffic flow and allow vehicles to safely access Murray Street.

Comments

The kerb space on the southern side of Murray Street west of South Dowling Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently unrestricted for parking.

On-site inspection shows there is a need to provide a "No Stopping" restriction to allow additional space for vehicles turning left into the street to safely access Murray Street and improve traffic flow.

Consultation

The City notified local residents and businesses in the area. There were 158 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
