Background

A business in McCauley Street, Alexandria has requested consideration of "2P 6am-6pm, Mon-Fri" along their frontage to increase turnover for parking for customers and discourage all day commuter parking.

Comments

The kerb space on the eastern side of McCauley Street south of McEvoy Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently unrestricted for parking.

To address businesses concerns in McCauley Street, it is proposed to install "2P 6am-6pm Mon-Fri". The two-hour parking would limit any vehicle to two hour of parking and increase parking turnover for customers and visitors to the area, where the signs are installed. The early start is required to match the operating hours of the adjacent business.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 24 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
