Background

A resident of Raglan Street, Waterloo has requested consideration of "No Parking" and "No Stopping" restrictions in Surrey Street. Parked cars in Surrey Street reduce the travel lane

width to only 2.3 metres which impacts the ability of vehicles to safely travel through the street to access residential driveways.

Comments

The kerb space on the western and eastern side of Surrey Street, south of Phillip Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently unrestricted for parking.

Surrey Street is approximately 4.4 metres wide and provides rear-lane property access to houses fronting Phillip Street and Raglan Street.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 84 letters sent out with no responses supporting the proposal and one response opposing the proposal because of loss of parking.

Funds are available in the current budget.
