Advice

Background

The recent removal of a driveway has left approximately 4 metres of unrestricted kerb space. Therefore, it is proposed to extend the adjacent 2 hour parking restrictions across this space to match the nearby restrictions.

Comments

The kerb space on the southern side of Bray Street, Erskineville, west of Concord Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently unrestricted for parking.

The kerb space will be allocated as "2P 8am-10pm, Permit Holders Excepted Area 36" to match adjacent parking restrictions in the street.

The proposed parking changes would limit any vehicle without an Area 36 parking permit to two hours of parking from 8am to 10pm seven days a week where the signs are installed.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 64 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.

Funds are available in the current budget.
