Background

Darlington Public School has requested zig zag line markings on approach to pedestrian crossings in Golden Grove and Abercrombie Streets, Darlington to improve safety for children. Therefore, we are proposing to install pavement marking on approaches to existing pedestrian crossings.

Comments

The installation of advance zig-zag pavement markings would increase awareness for drivers approaching the pedestrian crossings. This will help reduce vehicle speeds and improve safety for school children using the crossings.

On-site inspection shows there is a need to provide zig-zag markings to alert vehicles to the presence of the crossing.

Consultation
