Recommendations

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the following reallocation of parking in Conservatorium Road, Sydney east of Cahill Expressway:

- (A) On the southern side between the points 16.3 metres and 31.6 metres (three car spaces) as "No Parking"; and
- (B) On the eastern side between the points 43.5 metres and 61 metres (three car spaces) as "1/4P".

Background

Parents of students attending the Conservatorium High School and events at the Sydney Conservatorium have requested consideration to change parking to improve pick-up/drop-off opportunities along Conservatorium Road.

Comments

The kerb space on the southern side of Conservatorium Road, Sydney east of the Cahill Expressway, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as "No Stopping", "No Parking" and "1/4P".

On Conservatorium Road, there is a short section of "1/4P" parking (two parking spaces) to allow parents to park briefly to pick-up/drop-off their children at the school and conservatorium. At peak times especially during wet weather conditions, parents have raised concerns that there are inadequate pick-up/drop-off opportunities on Conservatorium Road.

On-site inspection showed that parking in Conservatorium Road can be changed to accommodate more pick-up/drop off opportunities. It is proposed to reallocate a section of "No Parking" on the eastern side of Conservatorium Road to "1/4P". It would allow parents to park up to a maximum time limit of 15 minutes to pick-up/drop-off their children to/from the school and Sydney Conservatorium.

There is 31.6 metres of "No Stopping" on the southern side of Conservatorium Road which was installed to keep the kerb space in front of the Sydney Conservatorium clear of parked vehicles. Sydney Conservatorium has informed the City that a section of "No Stopping" can be reallocated to "No Parking" to allow parents to park to pick-up/drop-off their children. In a "No Parking" zone drivers can stop up to a maximum time limit of two minutes and must also be within three metres of their vehicle.

Consultation

The proposed parking changes on Conservatorium Road only impacts the Sydney Conservatorium and the Sydney Conservatorium High School. Since there are no residential properties or businesses in the area, the City discussed the parking changes with the facilities team at the Sydney Conservatorium and they supported the changes.

Financial

Funds are available in the current budget.
