

3 spaces make up the precinct and fulfill different roles


Town Hall Precinct Public Domain Plan: Principles

The heart of central sydney




Unify the three different spaces, Town Hall Square, George Street and Sydney Square into one place for locals and visitors to experience. Create a livingroom for the city.

Emphasize The heritage buildings




The Town Hall precinct should enhance the experience of the heritage architecture as well as showing new ways of interacting with it.

Strong linkages above & below ground




Acknowledge subterranean retail and station spaces. Create good and legible connections to the underground.




Town Hall Precinct (Public Spaces Public Life Study 2020)

Sydney Square: Stage 1 - Project Scope



Inclusions:

- Renewal of ground surfaces, paving, stairs, including associated waterproofing, and drainage
- New public domain lighting, furniture and wayfinding signage to main square, western and eastern side of the cathedral
- Existing trees retained with new garden beds
- Investigate suitable options for the public sculpture "to Sail to Stop"
- Investigate removal of the flag poles and escalator from Kent Street to Lower Square

Exclusions:

- Any alterations to the structure or egress of Town Hall Arcade
- Relocation or reconfiguration of surface drainage
- Any decorative / feature lighting to Sydney Town Hall or Cathedral
- 4. New public art
- St Andrews Cathedral community garden works by SAP
- Any works to the boundary conditions south of the Cathedral, including existing cathedral boundary wall, sandstone gate posts, train station vent stacks
- 7. Vehicle control (operable bollards) from Bathurst Street – works by SAP
