Background

A resident of Walker Street, Waterloo has requested consideration of "No Stopping" in Brunswick Street as vehicles parked across the property's rear-lane entry way, restricts access to the property.

Comments

The kerb space on the northern side of Brunswick Street, Waterloo between Beaumont and Walker Streets, where the changes are proposed, is currently unrestricted for parking.

Brunswick Street is approximately 4.7 metres wide and provides rear-lane property access to houses fronting Walker and Beaumont Streets.

On-site inspection shows there is a need to provide a "No Stopping" restriction to maintain rear-lane property access.

Consultation

The City notified local residents and businesses in the area. There were 119 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.

Financial

Funds are available in the current budget.
